Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the *Police Legislation Amendment (Recognised Law Enforcement Officers) Act 2010* on 1 November 2010, except the amendments made to the *Police (Special Provisions) Act 1901* which repeal the provisions enabling the appointment of police officers from other jurisdictions as special constables and related savings and transitional provisions.
