The Administrator, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009.*

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend Schedule 3 to the *Government Information (Public Access) Regulation 2009* to declare that the following bodies are to be regarded as being part of the Department of Industry and Investment for the purposes of the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009*:

- (a) the advisory committee established under the *Food Act 2003*,
- (b) the Forestry Commission of New South Wales (also known as Forests NSW),
- (c) the Office of the NSW Food Authority,
- (d) the New South Wales Film and Television Office (also known as Screen NSW),
- (e) the NSW Food Authority,
- (f) Tourism New South Wales.

This Regulation is made under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009*, including section 129 (the general regulation-making power) and clause 6 of Schedule 4 (Regulations may declare agency to be part of another agency).
