(1) Schedule 1 Employers

Insert at the end of Part 1:

SITA (No. 1) Pty Ltd (limited to persons who, immediately before 31 January 2011, were employees of Waste Recycling and Processing Corporation)

(2) Schedule 1, Part 1

Omit the matter relating to Waste Recycling and Processing Corporation.
