Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Victims Support and Rehabilitation Regulation 2006* to exclude persons who are convicted of parking offences from any requirement to pay a compensation levy under the *Victims Support and Rehabilitation Act 1996*.

This Regulation is made under the *Victims Support and Rehabilitation Act 1996*, including sections 78 (1) and 88 (the general regulation-making power).
