Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe a further period (ending on 1 January 2014) during which the Commissioner of Police may disclose information relating to the circumstances of an offence or an alleged offence to approved interstate screening agencies for the purposes of interstate child-related employment screening.

This Regulation is made under the *Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998*, including sections 38A and 51 (the general regulation-making power).
