Explanatory note

The object of these Rules is to clarify that a person may apply for an order for assessed costs in the Supreme Court where the total amount of the unpaid costs that are included in more than one cost assessor's certificate filed together under rule 36.10 (1) and (2) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005* exceed \$150,000.
