Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Pawnbrokers and Second-hand Dealers Regulation 2008* to increase the fees payable in connection with the application for a licence under the *Pawnbrokers and Second-hand Dealers Act 1996*. The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index (rounded to the nearest dollar).

This Regulation is made under the *Pawnbrokers and Second-hand Dealers Act 1996*, including sections 9 (Application to licences of *Licensing and Registration (Uniform Procedures) Act 2002*), 13 (Register of licences) and 43 (the general regulation-making power) and, in particular, section 43 (1) (g).
