The object of this Order is to provide that the specified policy of professional indemnity insurance of Vero Insurance Limited and Allianz Australia Limited is approved by the Minister for Fair Trading from 1 July 2011 until 30 June 2012 for the purposes of clause 6 (2) (a) of the *Conveyancers Licensing Regulation 2006*, which requires a licensee to be insured under an approved policy.
