Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Sporting Venues (Invasions) Act 2003*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to remake, with minor amendments, the provisions of the *Sporting Venues (Invasions) Regulation 2006*, which is repealed on 1 September 2011 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

This Regulation makes provision with respect to the following:

- (a) prescribing the EnergyAustralia Stadium in Newcastle (also known as Newcastle Stadium) as a designated sporting venue for the purposes of the *Sporting Venues* (*Invasions*) Act 2003,
- (b) formal matters.

This Regulation is made under the *Sporting Venues (Invasions) Act 2003*, including sections 3 and 15 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely matters of a machinery nature and matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Sporting Venues (Invasions) Regulation 2011.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 September 2011 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

Note. This Regulation replaces the *Sporting Venues (Invasions) Regulation 2006* which is repealed on 1 September 2011 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

3 Definitions

- (1) In this Regulation:
 - the Act means the Sporting Venues (Invasions) Act 2003.
- (2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

4 Designated sporting venues

The EnergyAustralia Stadium in Newcastle (also known as Newcastle Stadium) is prescribed as a designated sporting venue for the purposes of the Act.
