## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to include the *Police Powers (Controlled Operations) Act 2006* of Tasmania in the list of corresponding laws for the purposes of the *Law Enforcement (Controlled Operations) Act 1997* of New South Wales. As a result, the protections provided by the New South Wales Act to ensure the lawfulness of controlled operations by law enforcement agencies extend to controlled operations that are authorised by or under the Tasmanian Act.

This Regulation is made under the *Law Enforcement (Controlled Operations) Act 1997*, including sections 4 (which provides for the amendment of the list of corresponding laws in Schedule 1 to the Act) and 31 (the general regulation-making power).
