Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include the National VET Regulator in the list of employers in Schedule 1 to the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*. That body will be an employer under the State Authorities Superannuation Non-contributory Superannuation Scheme only in relation to employees under that Scheme who, immediately before 1 July 2011, were employed in the Quality Assurance Services Directorate of the NSW Department of Education and Communities. The change in employment of these employees is a result of the State referral to the Commonwealth of powers relating to vocational training regulation.

This Order is made under section 27 (1) of the State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987.
