Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include the National VET Regulator in the list of employers in Schedule 3 to the *Superannuation Act 1916*. That body will be an employer under the State Superannuation Scheme only in relation to members of that Scheme who, immediately before 1 July 2011, were employed in the Quality Assurance Services Directorate of the NSW Department of Education and Communities. The change in employment of these members is occurring as a result of the State referral to the Commonwealth of powers relating to vocational training regulation.
