## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to recognise and give effect to certain child protection orders made under Queensland and South Australian legislation that are similar in nature to child protection prohibition orders made under section 5 of the *Child Protection (Offenders Prohibition Orders) Act 2004*.

This Regulation is made under the *Child Protection (Offenders Prohibition Orders) Act 2004*, including sections 19 (Recognition of prohibition orders made in other jurisdictions) and 21 (the general regulation-making power).
