Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to suspend, until 31 March 2012, the prohibition on promoting, or engaging in, a professional combat sport contest at premises licensed under the *Liquor Act 2007*.

This Regulation is made under the *Combat Sports Act 2008*, including sections 52 (1) (b) and (2) (b) and 73 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
