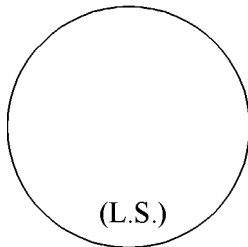
Business Names (Commonwealth Powers) Act 2011 No 44

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the provisions of the *Business Names (Commonwealth Powers) Act 2011* that refer certain matters to the Parliament of the Commonwealth under section 51 (xxxvii) of the Commonwealth Constitution and that provide for savings and transitional matters. Schedules 2 and 3 to the Act, which are not commenced, provide for the repeal and consequential amendment of certain legislation after Commonwealth legislation is enacted pursuant to the reference.
