Explanatory note

The object of this Rule is to amend the Supreme Court Rules 1970:

- (a) to insert a note that indicates the correct newly approved form for use in the publication of a notice of intended distribution under the *Probate and Administration Act 1898*, the *Succession Act 2006* or *Trustee Act 1925*,
- (b) to remove a reference to the form that, as a consequence of the approval of the new form for the publication of a notice of intended distribution, is redundant.
