Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to declare that the NSW Adult Migrant English Service is not to be regarded as a separate agency for the purposes of the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009* (*the Act*), but rather, as part of and included in the Department of Education and Communities.

This Regulation is made under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009*, including section 129 (the general regulation-making power) and clause 6 of Schedule 4 to the Act.
