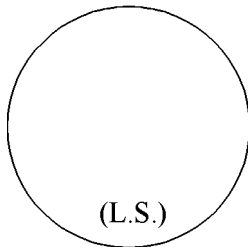
Planning Appeals Legislation Amendment Act 2010 No 120
