Explanatory note

On the commencement of the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011*, the District Court will have jurisdiction to hear certain criminal proceedings summarily.

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Criminal Procedure Regulation 2010* to include a fee of \$1,596 for filing an application to commence summary proceedings in the District Court (other than proceedings commenced by the secretary of an industrial organisation of employees).

This Regulation is made under the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986*, including sections 4 (the general regulation-making power) and 4A (Fees).
