Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2008* to provide for the special eligibility criteria for temporary overseas visitors in clause 43 of the Regulation to extend to visitors applying for learner licences as well as for other kinds of driver licences.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1998*, including sections 19 (the general regulation-making power) and 20.
