Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal the provisions of the *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Regulation 2000* that deal with out of school hours care services.

From 1 January 2012, those services will be regulated by the *Children (Education and Care Services) National Law (NSW)*.

This Regulation is made under the *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998*, including section 264 (the general regulation-making power).
