### Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Police Legislation Amendment (Recognised Law Enforcement Officers) Act 2010* on 1 March 2011. Those provisions contain amendments that:

- (a) repeal the provisions enabling the appointment of police officers from other jurisdictions as special constables, and
- (b) deal with related savings and transitional matters.
