Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to authorise Roads and Traffic Authority enforcement officers to issue penalty notices for over-height vehicle offences under the *Road Rules 2008* and for certain driving offences under those Rules (such as tail-gating or driving in the dark without lights on) that are committed in Safe-T-Cam zones or average speed detection zones. This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (General) Act 2005*, including section 10 (the general regulation-making power).

Insert ", 2" after "Class 1" in column 2 of paragraph (a) of the matter relating to rule 132 of the *Road Rules 2008*.
