Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to declare Byron local government area as an area for which the regional relocation grant is not available.

This Regulation is made under the *Regional Relocation (Home Buyers Grant) Act 2011*, including sections 4 (2) and 65 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Regional Relocation (Home Buyers Grant) Regulation 2012.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definition

In this Regulation:

the Act means the Regional Relocation (Home Buyers Grant) Act 2011.

4 Area for which regional relocation grant not available

For the purposes of section 4 (2) of the Act, Byron local government area is declared to be an area for which the regional relocation grant is not available.
