## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Valuers Regulation 2010* to increase the fees payable under the *Valuers Act 2003* in relation to the registration of a valuer.

The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index (rounded to the nearest dollar).

This Regulation is made under the *Valuers Act 2003*, including sections 10 (Application to registration of *Licensing and Registration (Uniform Procedures) Act 2002*), 15 (Cancellation of registration) and 48 (the general regulation-making power).
