Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend the date by which Narrabri Shire Council may resolve that the Electoral Commissioner is to administer its elections, council polls and constitutional referendums.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including section 748 (the general regulation-making power) and clause 102 of Schedule 8.

1 Name of Regulation

the following dates are prescribed:

- (a) in relation to Narrabri Shire Council—1 June 2012,
- (b) in any other case—30 November 2011.
