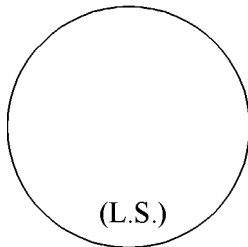
Road Transport (General) Amendment (Vehicle Sanctions) Act

### Explanatory note
