#### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Industrial Relations (General) Regulation 2001* (*the Principal Regulation*) to increase certain fees charged by the Industrial Relations Commission. This Regulation also makes some consequential changes to the Principal Regulation following the commencement of the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011* on 1 January 2012.

This Regulation is made under the *Industrial Relations Act 1996*, including sections 183 and 407 (the general regulation-making power).
