Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe staff of Transport for NSW as a class of persons who may be authorised by Roads and Maritime Services or any other roads authority to exercise the functions of an authorised officer under the *Roads Act 1993*.

This Regulation is made under the *Roads Act 1993*, including the definition of **authorised officer** in the Dictionary to the Act and section 264 (the general regulation-making power).
