The object of these Rules is to prescribe a Supreme Court registrar as an officer of the Supreme Court before whom an examination on oath of certain persons may be conducted, being persons the subject of an application for a confiscation order under the *Criminal Assets Recovery Act 1990* and spouses or de facto partners of such persons.
