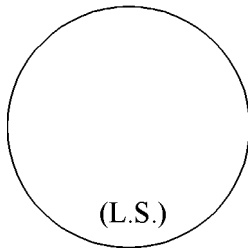
Police Amendment (Death and Disability) Act 2011 No 73

### Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the remaining uncommenced provisions of the *Police Amendment (Death and Disability) Act 2011* (**the amending Act**), which contain amendments to the *State Authorities Superannuation Act 1987* (**the Act**). Those amendments provide for the making of regulations with respect to police officers who elect to be covered under an approved insurance policy in accordance with Part 9B of the *Police Act 1990*, as amended by the amending Act, and to relinquish coverage for the additional benefit for incapacity under the Act.
