His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Marine Safety Act 1998*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Marine Safety (Commercial Vessels) Regulation* 2010 and *Marine Safety (General) Regulation 2009* to adjust certain fees payable under the *Marine Safety Act 1998*.

The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index (*CPI*). Under the *Marine Safety (General) Regulation 2009*:

- (a) the fees for the 3-year personal watercraft driving licences and boat driving licences are being increased by the CPI, but the fees for the 5-year personal watercraft driving licences and boat driving licences are being decreased to correct the discount gap between the 3-year and 5-year licences, and
- (b) the fee (\$19) for the replacement of a marine safety licence or vessel registration label is not being increased.

This Regulation also amends the *Marine Safety (Commercial Vessels) Regulation 2010* to correct a misdescription in respect of the fee for the issue of a new Certificate of Competency for a Coxswain or a Master of Vehicular Ferry in Chains.

This Regulation is made under the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, including sections 37 (2) (k) and 137 (the general regulation-making power).
