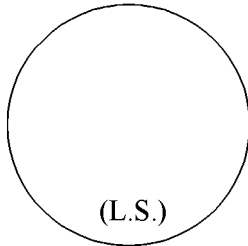

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain provisions of the *Heritage Amendment Act 2011*. The effect of those provisions is as follows:

- (a) to reduce the number of members of the Heritage Council from 11 to 9,
- (b) to require the Heritage Council, once it makes a decision to recommend the listing of an item on the State Heritage Register under section 33 of the *Heritage Act 1977* (the *Act*), to make the recommendation to the Minister within 14 days of giving of notice of the decision,
- (c) to require the publication of certain written submissions made by the Heritage Council to a consent authority in relation to certain State significant development that affects State heritage matters,

Explanatory note

- (d) to enable the Heritage Council, rather than the Minister, to approve forms for the purposes of the Act,
- (e) to update certain references to public office holders.
