Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to make a minor consequential amendment to reflect the proposed changes to the requirement to affix registration labels to vehicles (the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Amendment (Registration Labels) Regulation 2012* abolishes the requirement that registration labels be issued and affixed to light motor vehicles and trailers).

This Regulation is made under the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*, including Part 13.

1 Name of Regulation
