



Coastal Protection Amendment (Code of Practice) Regulation 2012

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Coastal Protection Act 1979*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to update a reference to a Code of Practice specified in the *Coastal Protection Regulation 2011*. That Regulation provides that requirements specified in the Code of Practice must be complied with in relation to:

- (a) the placement, maintenance and removal of temporary coastal protection works, and
- (b) orders to remove material, structures and temporary coastal protection works on beaches, and
- (c) the restoration of land after the removal of material, structures and temporary coastal protection works.

This Regulation is made under the *Coastal Protection Act 1979*, including sections 55P (2) (f), 55R (1) (d), 55Y (1) (b), 55ZA (3) (b), 55ZC (5) (b) and 60 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Coastal Protection Amendment (Code of Practice) Regulation 2012*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 21 January 2013 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

Clause 3 Definitions
