#### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Order is to include RSL LifeCare Limited in the list of employers in Schedule 1 to the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*. That body will be an employer under the State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Scheme only in relation to employees under that Scheme who, immediately before 23 January 2012, were employed under Part 1 of Chapter 9 of the *Health Services Act 1997* and assigned to work at the Governor Phillip Nursing Home, Penrith, or the Queen Victoria Memorial Home, Picton.
