Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to add to the list of Class A declared diseases affecting fish and marine vegetation under the *Fisheries Management Act 1994* (being diseases that are the subject of various offences under the Act and in relation to which the Minister may declare a quarantine area).

This Regulation is made under the *Fisheries Management Act 1994*, including sections 182 (3) and 289 (the general regulation-making power).
