## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Order is to notify the number that equates to the factor  $\frac{B}{C}$  used in the formula for calculating the variation of the weekly payment to be paid to a worker under section 82A of the *Workers Compensation Act 1987*. That section provides that weekly payments are to be varied on 1 April and 1 October in each year.

This Order is made under section 82A (4) of the Workers Compensation Act 1987.

### 1 Name of Order

This Order is the Workers Compensation (Weekly Payments Indexation) Order 2013.

#### 2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### 3 Definition

(1) In this Order:

the Act means the Workers Compensation Act 1987.

2) Notes included in this Order do not form part of this Order.

#### 4 Variation of weekly payments

For the purposes of section 82A (4) of the Act, the number that equates to the factor  $\frac{B}{C}$  for the purposes of the variation of a weekly payment on the review date specified in Column 1 of the Table to this clause is the number specified in Column 2 of that Table opposite that date.

Column 1	Column 2
Review date	Number equating to factor $\frac{B}{C}$
1 April 2013	1.0179

Note. The number equating to the factor  $\frac{B}{C}$  has been rounded to 4 decimal places.
