Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to remove a provision (inserted by the *Parliamentary Remuneration Amendment (Acting Premier) Regulation 2013* on 22 February 2013) that would have entitled the Deputy Premier to an additional salary and expense allowance when acting for or on behalf of the Premier under section 36 of the *Constitution Act 1902*.

This Regulation is made under the *Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989*, including sections 6 (4) and 21 (the general regulation-making power).
