**1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Passenger Transport (Drug and Alcohol Testing) Amendment (NSW Forensic & Analytical Science Service) Regulation 2013*.

**2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

**3 Amendment of Passenger Transport (Drug and Alcohol Testing) Regulation 2010**

**Clause 3 Definitions**

Omit “Division of Analytical Laboratories, ICPMR, Health Reform Transitional Organisation Western” from paragraph (a) of the definition of *approved laboratory* in clause 3 (1).

Insert instead “NSW Forensic & Analytical Science Service”.
