1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Amendment (NSW Forensic & Analytical Science Service) Regulation 2013*.

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 1999

Clause 129 Analysis of oral fluid, blood and urine samples—prescribed laboratory

Omit “Division of Analytical Laboratories, ICPMR, Health Reform Transitional Organisation Western”.

Insert instead “NSW Forensic & Analytical Science Service”.
