Explanatory note

On 1 March 2013, the Local Government Association of New South Wales and the Shires Association of New South Wales (*the former Associations*) were amalgamated under the *Industrial Relations Act 1996* to form the Local Government and Shires Association of New South Wales (*the amalgamated Association*).

The object of this Order is to update the list of employers in Schedule 1 to the *State Authorities Superannuation Act 1987* to include the amalgamated Association. This will mean that employees of the amalgamated Association who were employees of the former Associations, and were covered by the State Authorities Superannuation Scheme, immediately before 1 March 2013 will continue to be covered by that Scheme.
