Explanatory note

On 1 March 2013, the Local Government Association of New South Wales and the Shires Association of New South Wales (*the former Associations*) were amalgamated under the *Industrial Relations Act 1996* to form the Local Government and Shires Association of New South Wales (*the amalgamated Association*).

The object of this Order is to update the list of employers in Schedule 3 to the *Superannuation Act 1916* to include the amalgamated Association. This will mean that employees of the amalgamated Association who were employees of the former Associations, and were covered by the State Superannuation Scheme, immediately before 1 March 2013 will continue to be covered by that Scheme.

This Order is made under section 92 of the *Superannuation Act 1916*.
