His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Conveyancing Act 1919*.

Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to increase the fees that are payable to the Registrar-General under the *Conveyancing Act 1919*, and
- (b) to remove the GST component from the 2 fees relating to a public search of the General Register of Deeds.

The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index.

This Regulation is made under the *Conveyancing Act 1919*, including sections 64 (1) and 202 (the general regulation-making power).

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Conveyancing (General) Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2013.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 July 2013 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
