Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe Datacom Connect Pty Ltd as an approved person for the purposes of section 12 of the *Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Act 2013*, so as to enable that company to enter into an agreement with Service NSW to act as its agent pursuant to that section.

This Regulation is made under the *Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Act 2013*, including section 12 (2) and section 21 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act* 1989—namely, matters of a machinery nature.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Regulation 2013.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definitions

In this Regulation:

the Act means the Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Act 2013.

4 Approved persons

For the purposes of section 12 of the Act, Datacom Connect Pty Ltd (ABN 16 103 112 303) is prescribed as an approved person.
