Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to remove a modification to the *Food Standards Code* of the Commonwealth (as it applies in New South Wales) that relates to dogs in outdoor dining areas of food businesses. The amendment is made as a consequence of a change to the relevant provision of the *Food Standards Code* which now enables food businesses to allow dogs in outdoor dining areas.

This Regulation is made under the *Food Act 2003*, including section 139 (the general regulation-making power).
