Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Passenger Transport Regulation 2007* to enable members of staff of Sydney Trains to be appointed to exercise the functions of authorised officers in relation to all modes of transport under the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*. Currently, members of staff of Sydney Trains are only prescribed as authorised officers in relation to rail passenger services and railway premises.

This Regulation is made under the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*, including sections 46W and 63 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
