Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase (from \$151 to \$156 and from \$76 to \$78, respectively) the fees payable under the *Relationships Register Act 2010* for an application for the registration of a relationship and an application to revoke the registration of a relationship.

This Regulation is made under the *Relationships Register Act 2010*, including sections 6 (c), 11 (2) (c) and 17 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
