1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Health Services Amendment (Smoke-free Area) Regulation 2013*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 January 2014 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Health Services Regulation 2008

Clause 20

Insert after clause 19:

20 Smoke-free areas

The following outdoor public places (within the meaning of the *Smoke-free Environment Act 2000*) are designated as smoke-free areas for the purposes of section 6A (Smoke-free areas—outdoor public places) of that Act:

any outdoor public place at Albury Hospital, 201 Borella Road, Albury
