Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to define the waters of Lake Oberon as alpine waters for the purposes of making the wearing of lifejackets on board vessels operating in that lake compulsory.

This Regulation is made under the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, including sections 67 and 137 (the general regulation-making power).
